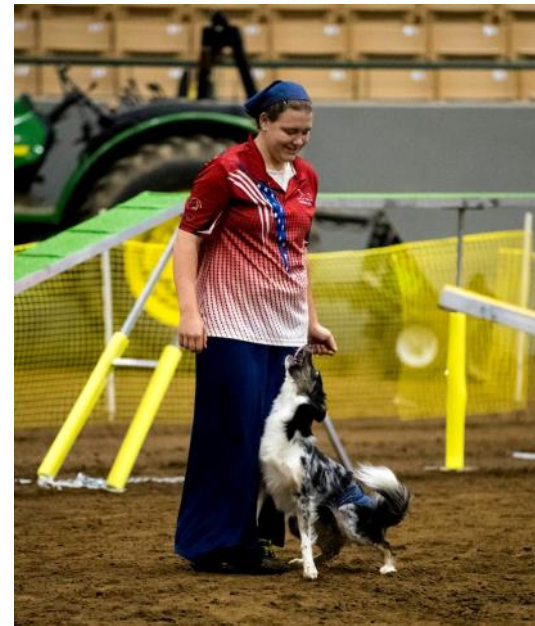


# Agility Workshops w/ Alice Reinkemeyer
